The above site has the greatest stage make-up and a great price. They have a minimum order of \$20. Best order as a group.

All the make-up that is necessary is highlighted in yellow.

Gothic Tribal has "\*GT" next to it

Smoldering temptress look has "\*ST"

If good for both looks then "Both"

For Smoldering Temptress I suggest Googling "Smokey Eye Kit" and see whatcha can get for cheap. I like Revlon's eye quads a lot and they are inexpensive and last. Smokey can be in Silver/Black combos, Brown/Pale Rose combos or Brown/Beige combos.

See which color you vibe with most and go with it.

## **From the stage and make-up site I suggest:**

LXS-20 : Ben Nye Lumiere Luxe Sparkle in "Starry Night"

\$11.00

This comes in a nice size jar with a cool shaker top...thee product I can't live without! Has black shadow base with cosmetic grade sparkles that really glimmer under lights.

Manic panic's new pigment glimmers are called "Coffin Dust"...if you don't like glitter.....the black is awesome but any color will do!

### **From L'oreal:**

Hip Pigment Line

Metallic Shadow duo in "Platinum" (black and silver combo) \*GT

Metallic Shadow duo "Sculpted" (wine/antique)\* ST

Cream shadow in Steely (909) \*both\*

Shocking pigment in Unashamed (544) also a great antique wine. \*ST\*

### **From MAC:**

Paint pot in "Blackground" similar to L'oreal's Steely, just more intense black and more \$. Either Steely or Blackground will do.

### **From Revlon:**

Colorstay liquid eyeliner in "Blackest Black" I use this for tribal face markings and my liquid eyeliner

### **BRUSHES:**

Any small angled brush will do and it is necessary to smoke out your eyes and apply fine liners, glitters, etc.

I like MAC's #266 but you can find cheaper from Sonia Kashuk or elsewhere at a drugstore. I just bought a fluffy eyeshadow brush from Sonia Kashuk that I use for almost everything when I am in a rush. Her stuff is at Target.

I am big on using my clean fingertips to apply make-up as well. Its primitive and I dig it.

### **You should also bring:**

- Table top or Compact Mirror
- Almay eye make up remover (oil free for contact lense wearers)
- Your best oil-free face powder (MAC studio fix is my savior!)
- Your best black Mascara ( I love Voluminous in Carbon Black from L'oreal)
- Your best waterproof eyeliner ( a must for performing)
- Your best dark wine lipstick (Blackberry from Revlon RULES!, MAC makes some great ones too: Siren, Media, Underworld)

**I will provide:**

- Q-tips
- Tissues
- Disposable foam brushes
- Mac Make-up wipes (some may be sensitive so bring Almay make-up remover pads if you are)
- Kick-ass music mixes by DJ VIVA to be inspired by : )~

Come with face washed, moisturized, and with foundation and concealer on if you wear it.  
Wheeeeeeeeeeeee!!!
